

**TOWN OF DAYTON
COUNCIL MEETING
August 2, 2023**

The regular meeting of the Dayton Town Council was called to order at 6:00 p.m. in the Dayton Town Hall. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited.

Members present: Mayor Reed, Councilors Alley, Logan, Perkins, and Grover.

Also Present: See the attached list of other attendees, which is made a part of the minutes by this reference.

Councilor Perkins moved to approve the agenda. Councilor Grover seconded the motion. There were no additions or deletions. All approved, motion passed.

Councilor Grover moved to approve the July 18, 2023, Master Water Plan Work Study minutes with Councilor Logan seconding. All approved, motion passed.

Councilor Perkins moved to approve the July 19, 2023, regular council minutes with Councilor Logan seconding. All Approved, motion passed.

There were no department or other reports.

Citizens Communiqué: Comments on the attendance/interaction of the mayor and council during Dayton Days was made, and thanks given to them. Concerns that the bathrooms were closed and that they should be repaired so they could be used for such events. There were additional comments regarding the parade fees; too high? The master of ceremony was an unpopular choice for some. The bridge needs to be swept.

Councilor Perkins made a motion to approve warrants with Councilor Grover seconding. All approved, motion passed.

Old Business: None

Mayor's Updates & Announcements: The mayor reported that the BBQ pits and band shell wall were repaired before Dayton Days and there were 4 new trees planted in the park. Clearmont cancelled the planned financial budget training, however; Caselle will be offering online training on August 23rd from 9am to 5pm (90-minute lunch). The C Vine hearing was held, with a not-guilty plea entered; therefore, a trial date will be set, probably in early September.

Agenda Item #1. WWTP Pay Application #4 Approval. The mayor had visited the lagoon site and commented that there had not been very much accomplished for about 3 weeks. When he spoke with Mountain View Builders, he was assured that now that the concrete had cured, work would begin again. Councilor Alley made a motion to approve payment of Mountain View Builder Pay App #4 with Councilor Perkins seconding. All approved, motion passed.

Council Comments: Councilor Alley and the mayor thanked the law enforcement presence during Dayton Days. The status of the vacuum truck bid was discussed.

With no further business to come before the board, Councilor Alley made a motion to adjourn; Councilor Perkins seconded. All approve, motion passed; the meeting was adjourned at 6:14 pm. The mayor announced that he and the council would go into Executive Session 16-4-405 ii Personnel; and not return to the meeting.
